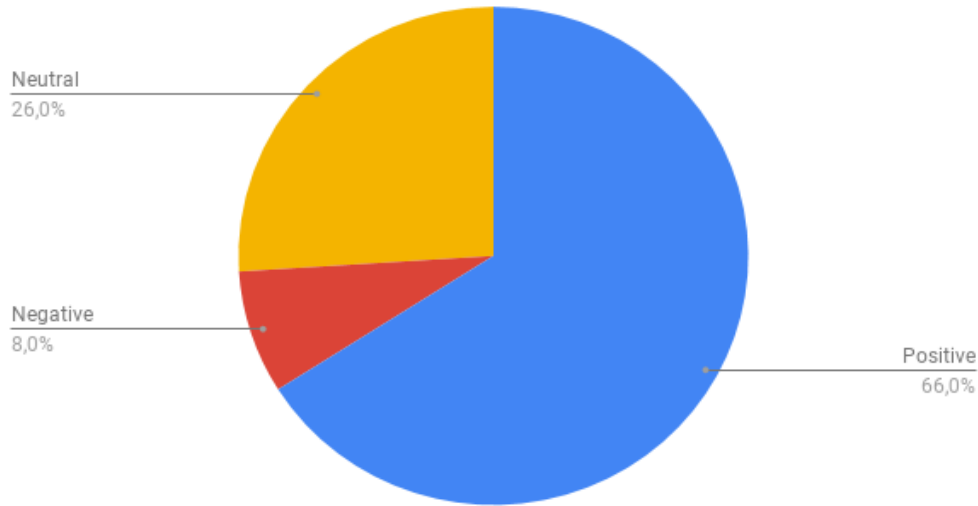

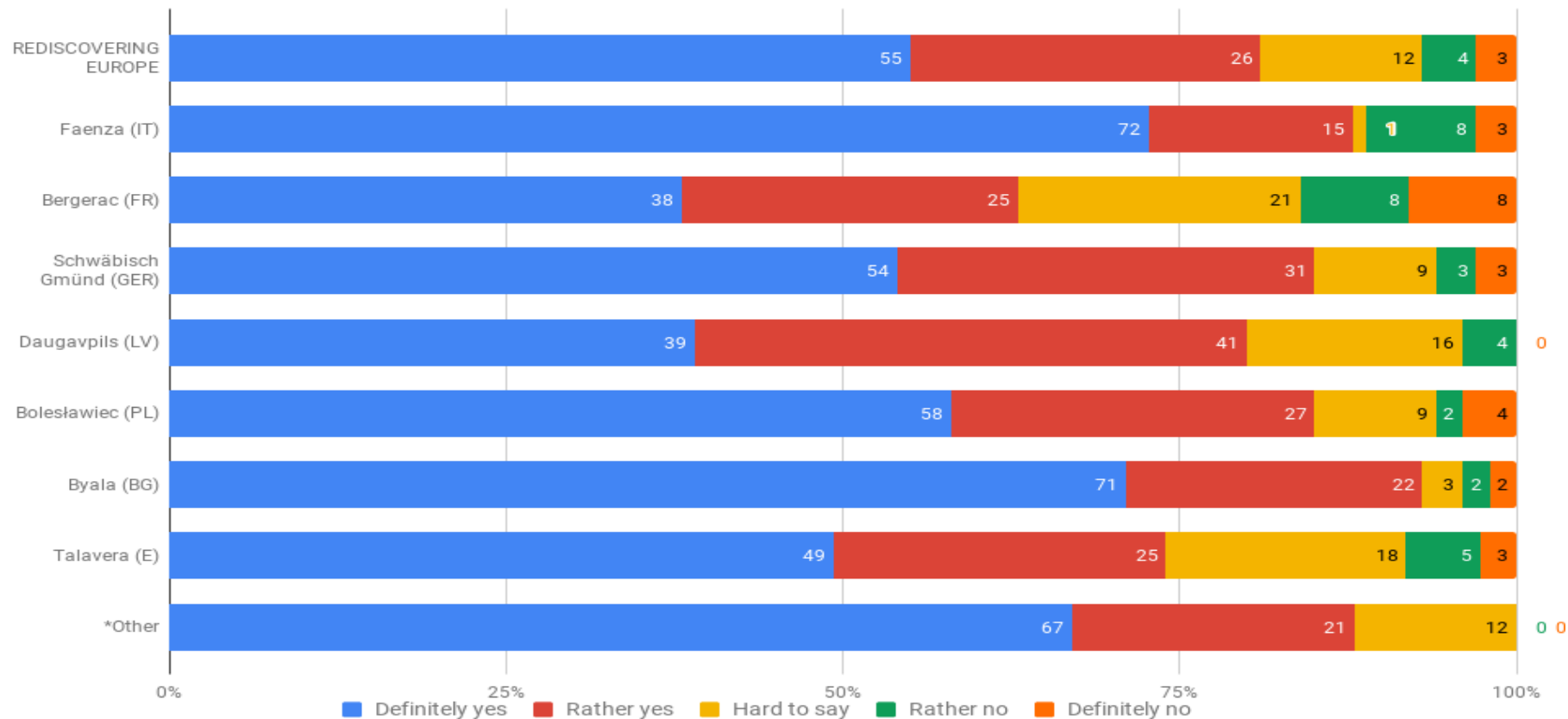

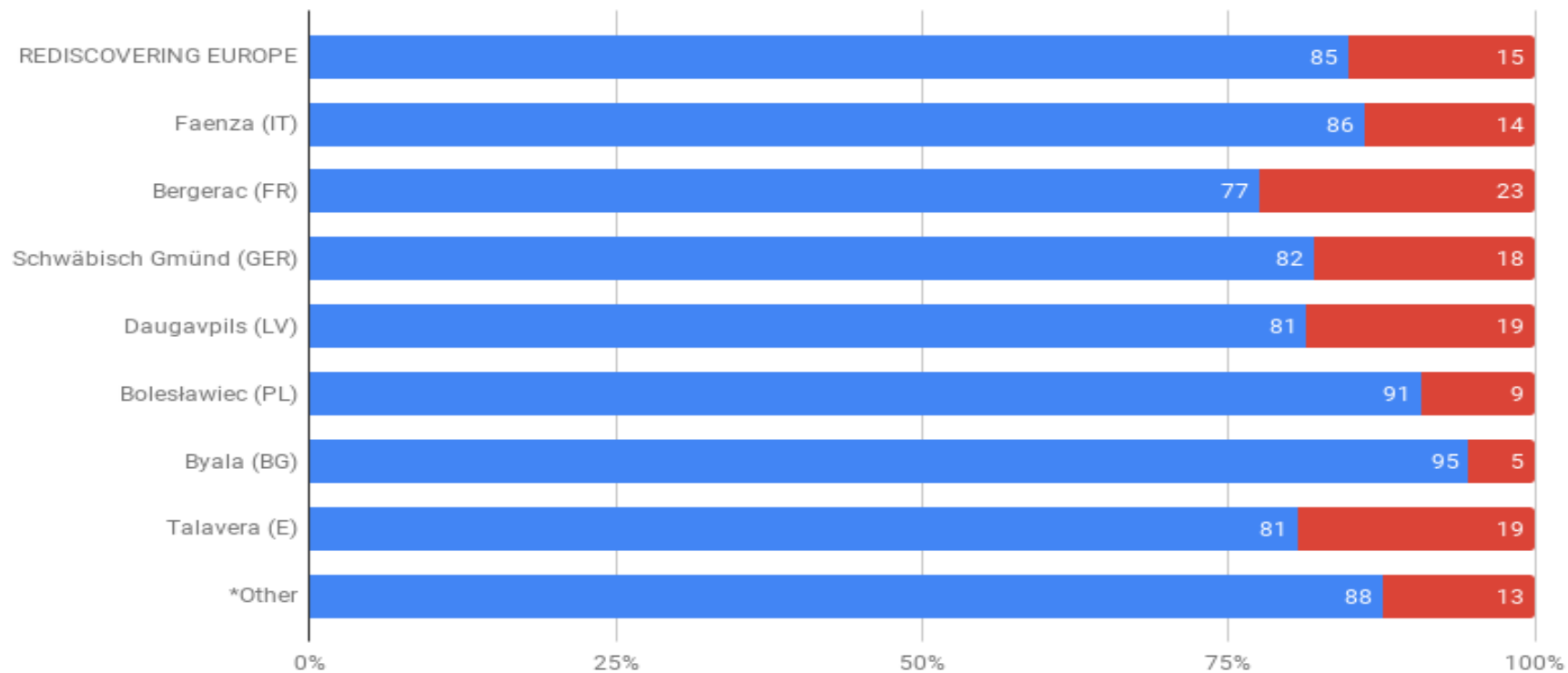
Are you content with the fact that your country is a part of the EU ? (percentage)

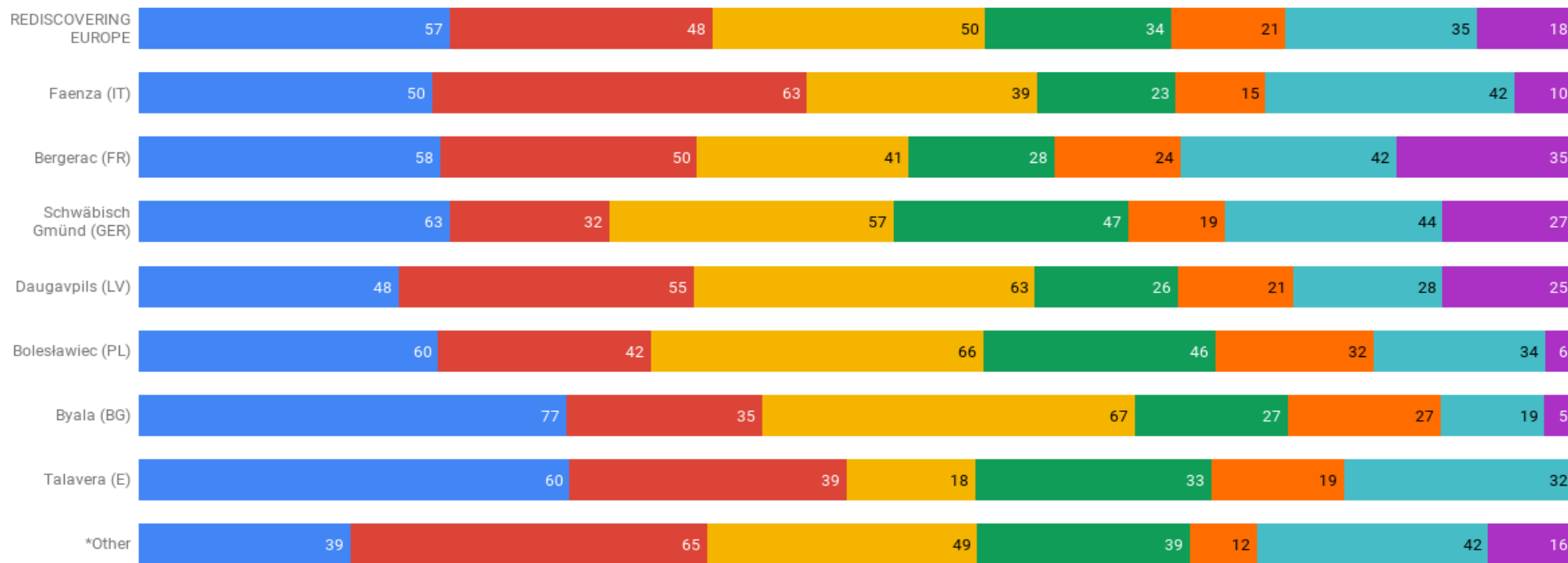

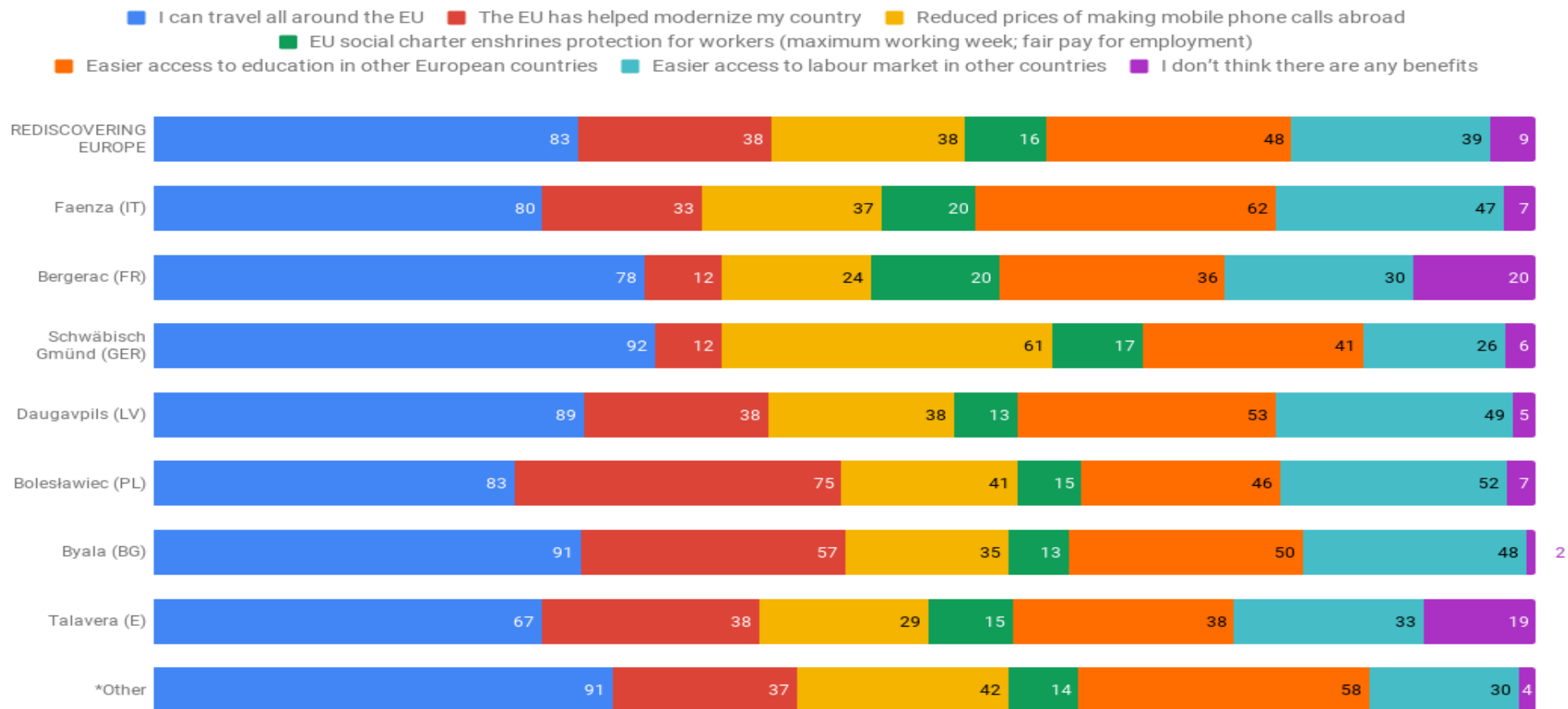

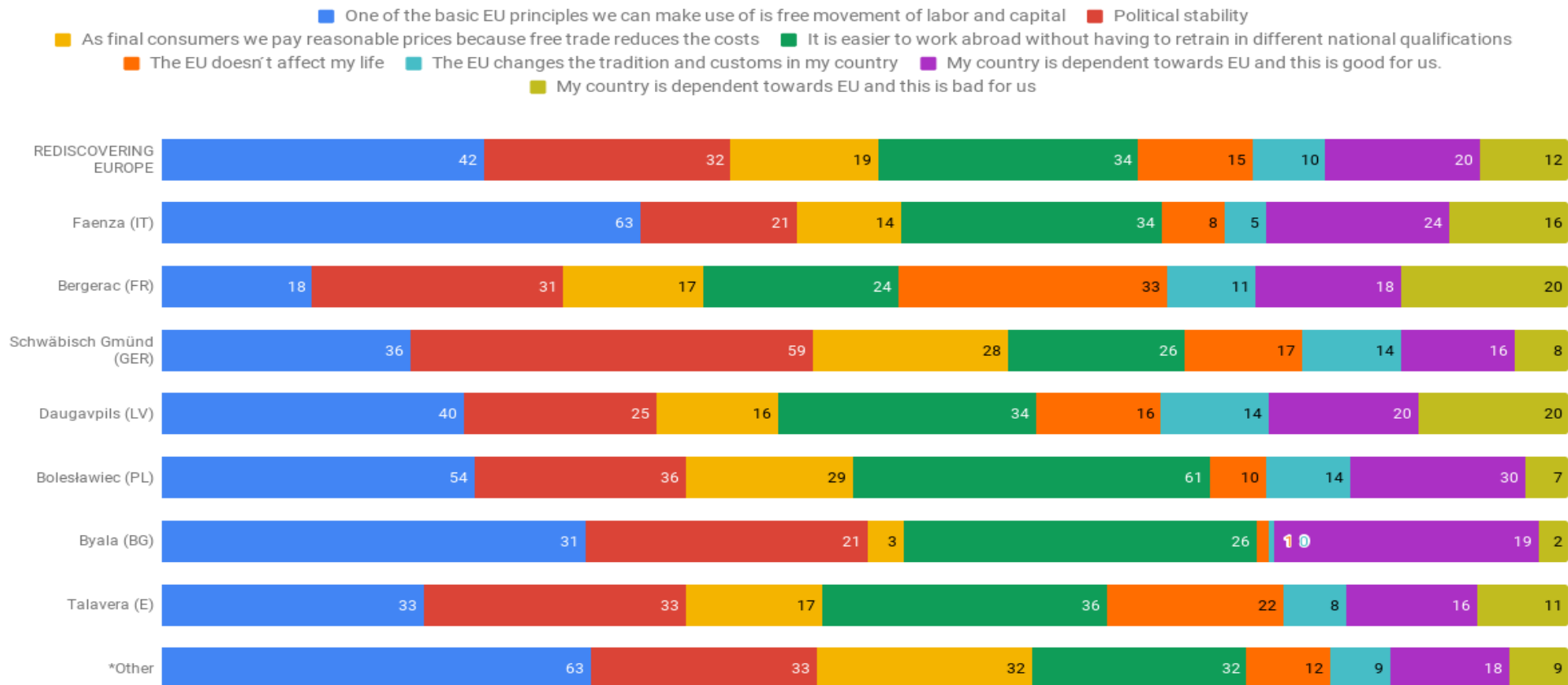
What advantages have you received of the EU membership? (more than one option is available):

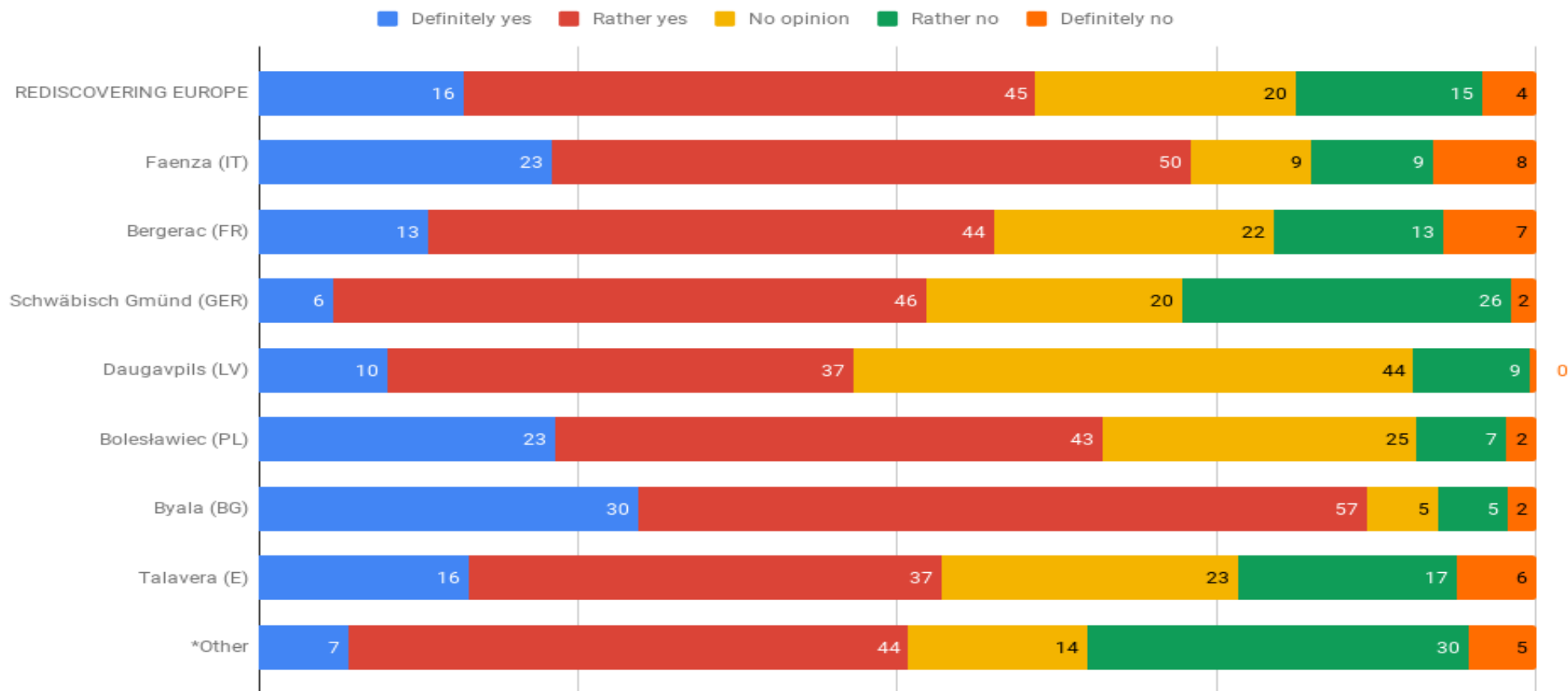


How does the EU affects your life? (more than one option is available):

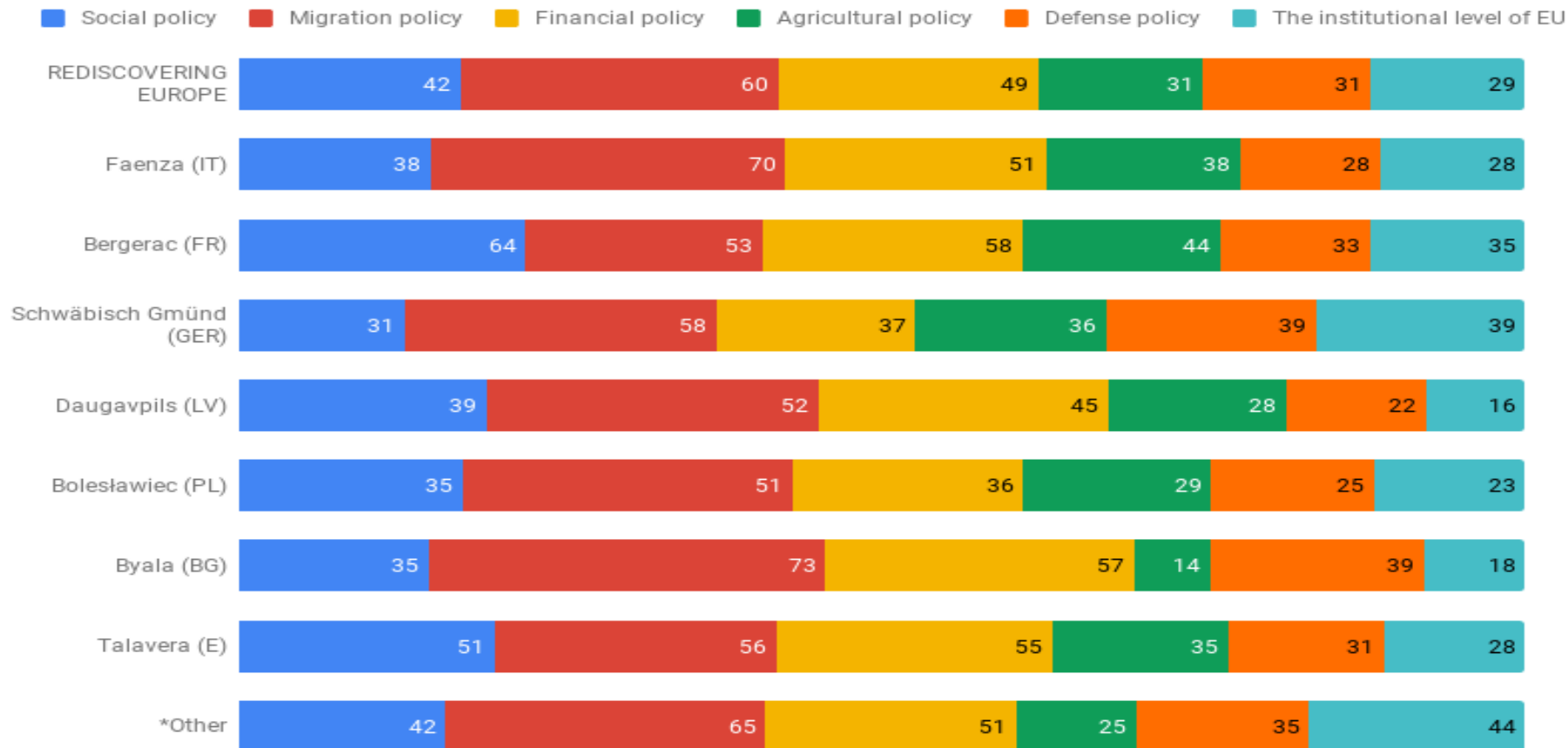


Do EU institutions have a capacity to cope with challenges? (percentage)

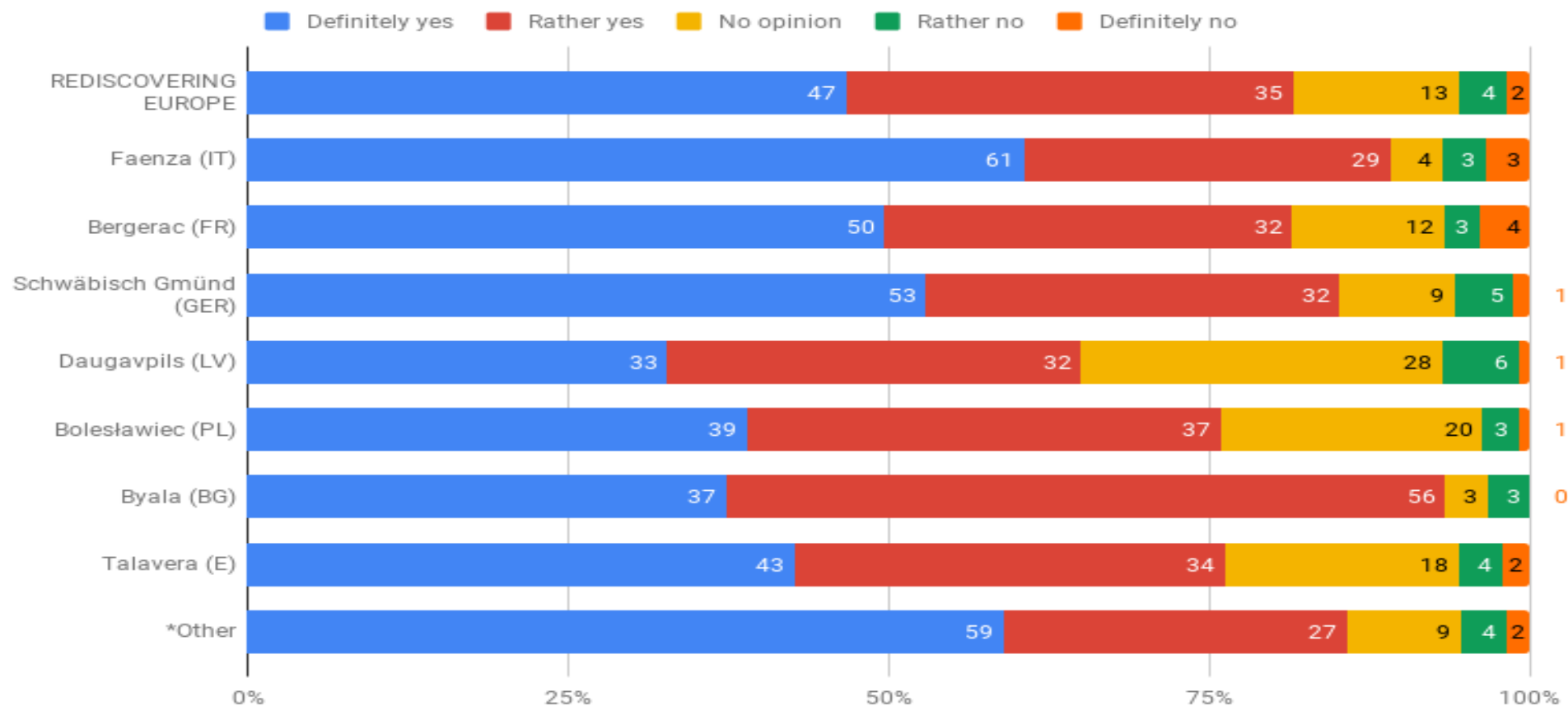


What would you like to change about EU? (more than one option is available):

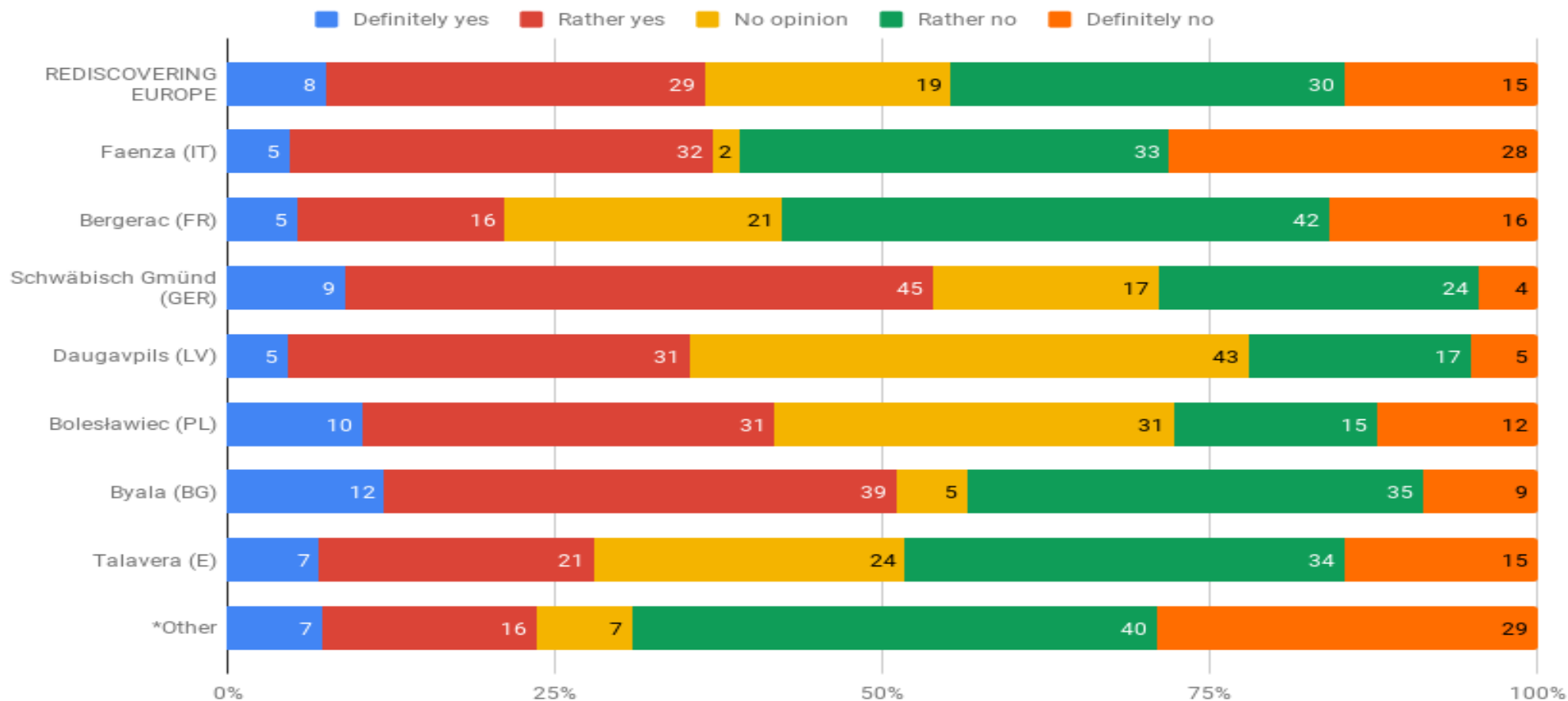


Is diversity, in your opinion, important for the EU? (percentage)

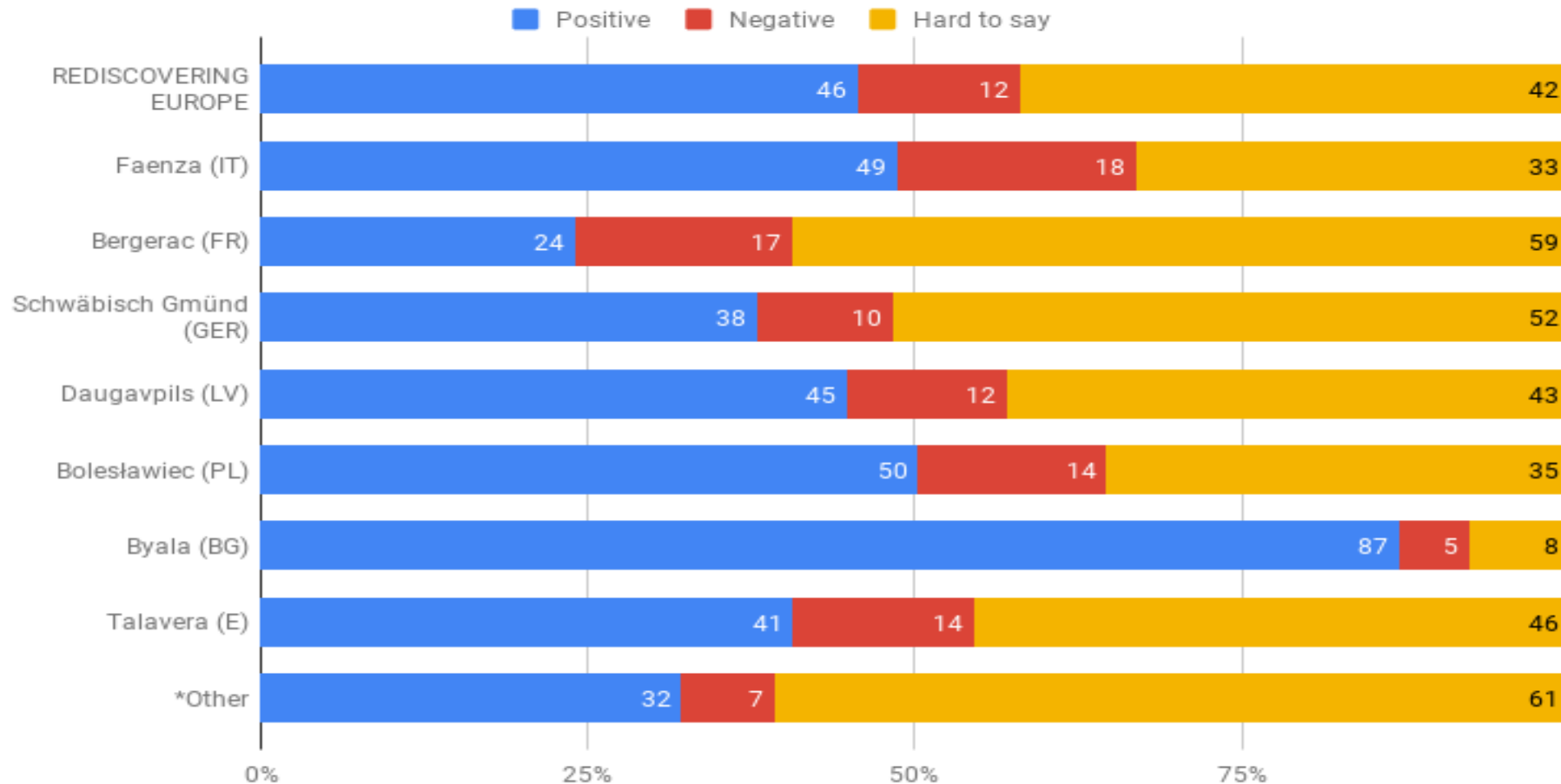


Do you think that Europe's response to immigration and humanitarian aid is good?

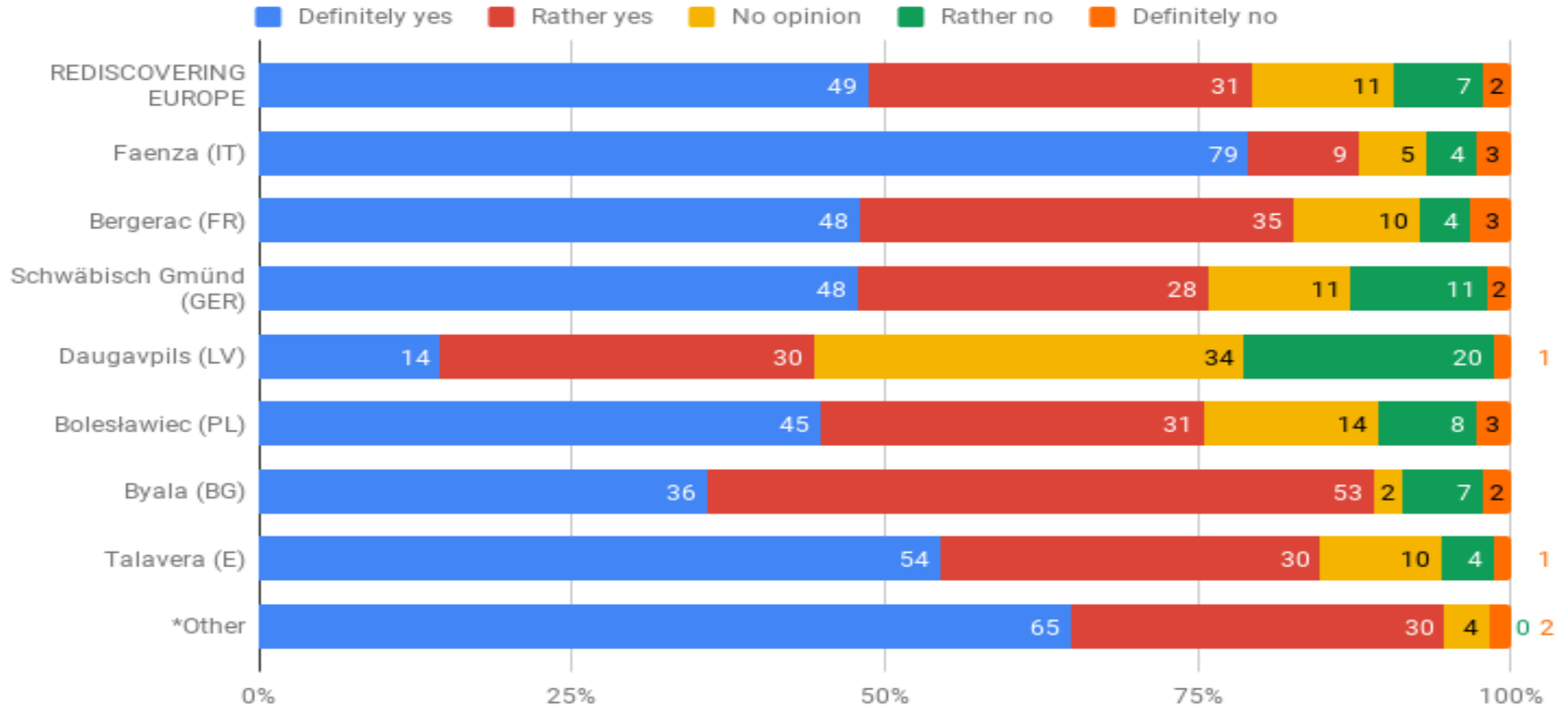


In my opinion the future of Europe is: (percentage)

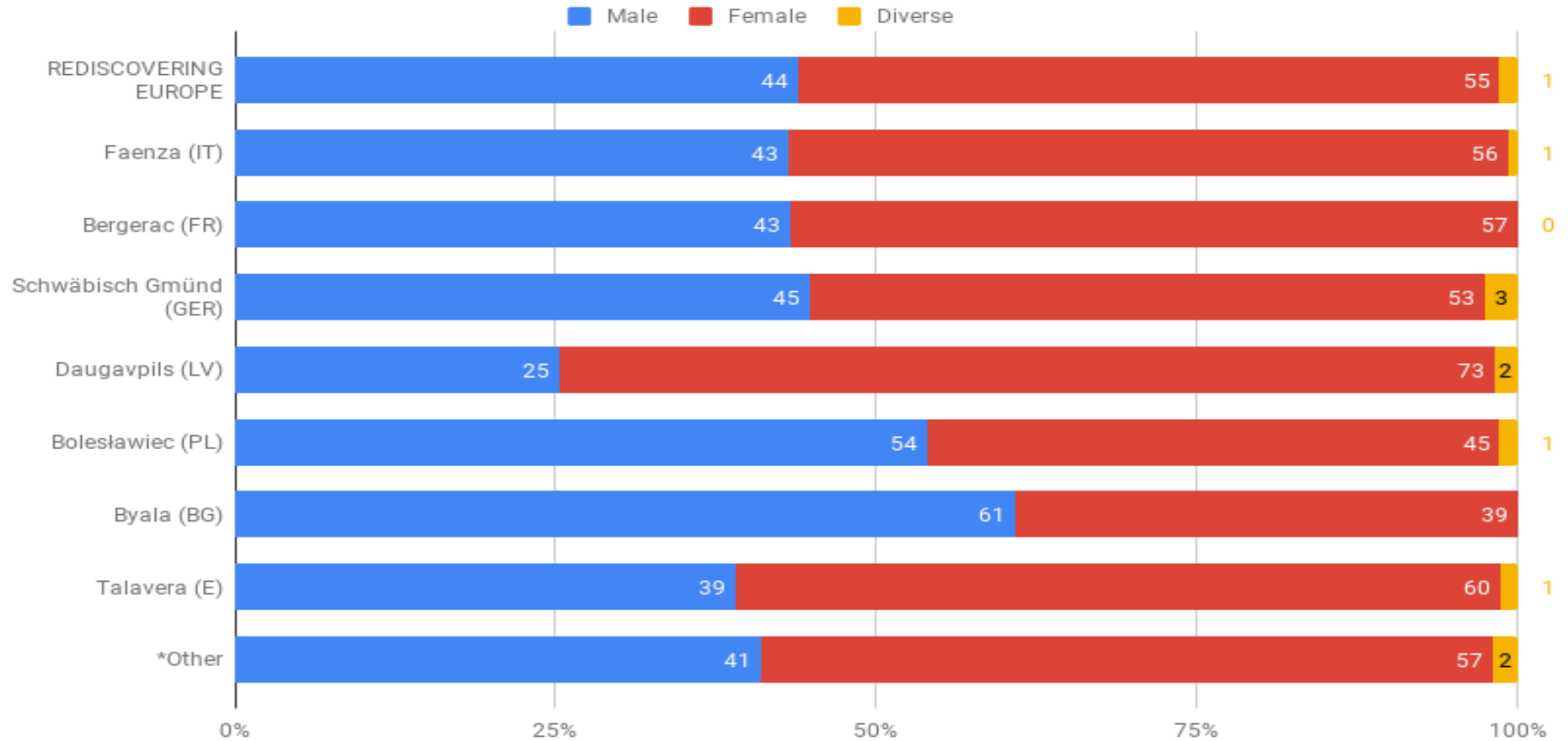

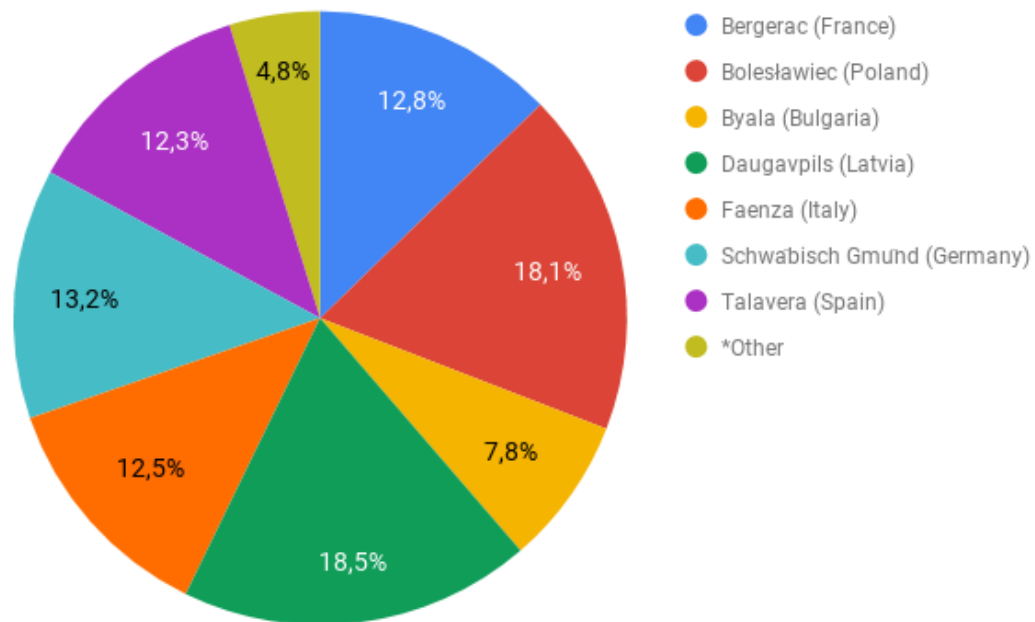

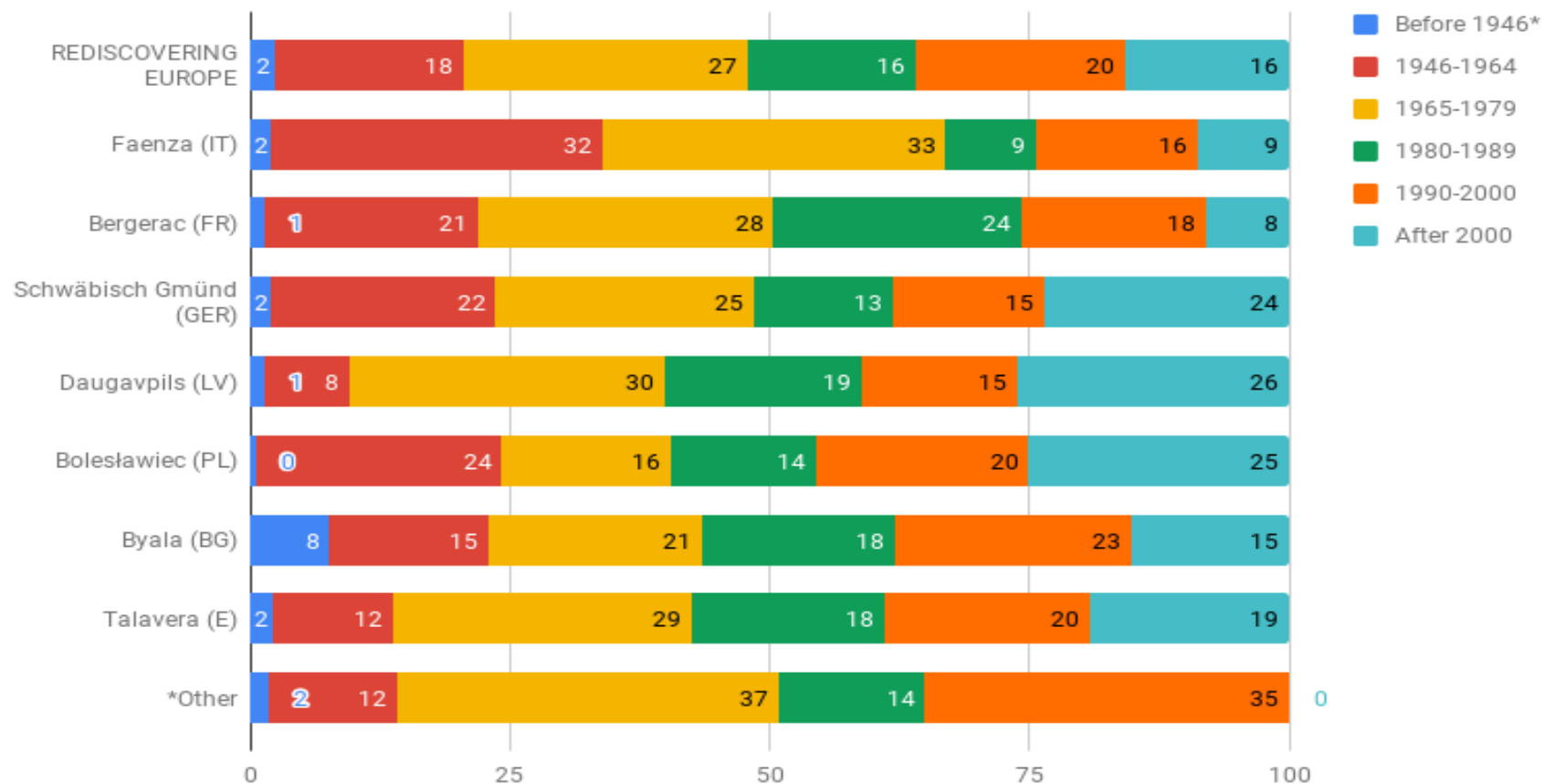

Main conclusions

- .81 % of respondents claim they are content with the fact that their country is a part of the EU.
- .In a several questions Byala was the most optimistic towards the EU and Bergerac the least optimistic.
- .85 % of respondents feel european, 15 % do not.
- .48% of respondents who do not feel europeans claim it's because EU institutiots don't represent interests.
- .21 % of respondents claim that it is necceserary to be born in Europe to feel europeans.
- . 83 % of respondents picked travelling across EU as an advantage they received
- . from EU, only 16 % picked protection for workers.

Main conclusions

- 60 % of respondents would like to change EU migration policy.
- 82 % of respondents claim that diversity is important for the EU.
- 37 % of respondents claim the EU response to immigration and humanitarian aid was right, 45 % disagree. No opinion option changes from 2 % (Faenza) to 43 % (Daugavpils)
- 46 % of respondents claim that the future of the EU is positive, in Byala 87 % claim that.
- 80 % of respondents claim that EU should unite more, above average Faenza- 87 %.
